■ Yongin Campus, KLEC

The City of Yongin, where the Natural Science Campus is located, is known as the biggest of the educational cities in the metropolitan area. Known as the center for Korea's hightech industry, Yongin has been a popular destination for the semiconductor industry, and many other high tech-relates facilities, including the control center for the Mugunghwa communications satellites. It is also endowed with rich elements of cultural heritage, attracting many foreigners to experience Korean culture and traditions. Myongji University's Natural Science Campus is also easily accessible from Seoul, less than one hour by public transportation or by car. ■ Seoul&Yongin Campus Overview

- Class size: Approximately 15 students per class
- Course: Level 1 ~ 6
- Class Hours: 10 weeks per semester, 5 days a week(Mon~Fri), 4 hours per day (200 hours in total)
- Class hour per level: lev.1~2: 14:00 ~18:00, lev.3~6: 09:00 ~13:00
- Text Book: Seoul University Publisher Textbook 1~6
- Course Language: Korean
- Online placement test(RC/SP) will be done 3 weeks before the class start

Applicant requirement

- 1. Those who have a high school diploma or higher
- 2. Those who have graduated from their last degree within 2-year % If you have graduated 2 or more years from your last degree, please submit supplemental documents which can explain the blank period. (employment or career certificate, language training certificate, etc.)

■ Application Process (from abroad)

- [Applicant] Send the required documents via POST
- [University] Reviews documents and notifies admission result(online) *Will be notifies online after 3 weeks from the submission deadline
- [Applicant] Make the payments
- [University] Sends Certificate of Admission and other documents
- [Applicant] Visit the Korean Embassy/Consulate located in their home country to apply for visa

■ Fees (2025)

1. Seoul Campus, KLEC

- Application fee: 50,000 KRW * will NOT be refunded
- Tuition: 1,500,000 KRW /per semester
- * includes insurance fee, 4 textbooks and cultural program fee (once)

2. Yongin Campus, KLEC

- Application fee: 50,000 KRW ** will NOT be refunded
- Tuition: 1,300,000 KRW /per semester
- * includes insurance fee, 4 textbooks and cultural program fee (once)

3. Notice in common

- Applicants from abroad must wire at least 2 semesters tuition in advance.
- * Some of the country need to wire 4 semesters tuition in advance.
- Other expenses: bank commission from abroad- 10,000 KRW
 It differes from countries and banks
- Fees could be change
- Tuition may increase in every Spring semester. Those who already made the payment will ask to pay additional fee due to the tuition increase. (Newcomer only)

4. Food expenses in Korea

- Seoul campus student cafeteria: 6,000 KRW ~7,000 KRW / per meal
- Yongin campus student cafeteria: 6,500 KRW / per meal
- \bullet Restaurant out of the campus: 8,000 KRW \sim 10,000 KRW / per meal
